






Count of Course delivery by the faculty member in the class are interesting, interactive and participative

Count of Percentage usage of teaching aids and ICT in the class by faculty to facilitate teaching










Count of Opportunities for out of class room learning (guest lectures, seminars, workshop, value added programmes,




