Details of the Programme

Socially relevant Malayalam movie 'The Great Indian Kitchen' was screened on 18-07-2022 by Film Club in association with WDC. The objective of the programme was to make the students experience a realistic indictment of the patriarch, which shows that we still have a long way in front of us. The movie was an eye opener to the students. It's a universal story. A woman's struggle in the kitchen is the story of almost all women in India.

The Great Indian Kitchen is a 2021 Indian Malayalam-language drama film written and directed by Jeo Baby. The film tells the story of a newly wed woman (Nimisha Sajayan) who struggles to be the submissive wife that her husband (Suraj Venjaramood) and his family expect her to be. The music was composed by Sooraj S. Kurup and Mathews Pulickan.

Writer-director Jeo Baby's The Great Indian Kitchen aka Mahaththaya Bharatiya Adukkala is a Great Indian Film that captures an under-discussed horrific reality with astonishing



accuracy, by merely replicating on screen what happens in millions of Indian households. It is in Malayalam, but the title reminds us that patriarchy knows no state borders. The characters have no names because they are you and I and everyone around. The movie is a scathing indictment of the patriarchal institution that marriage is in India, even in the 21st century.

The movie gained a lot of public attention from audiences around the country and has received numerous praises from critics as well. The film highlights the plight of women confined to kitchens. The film deals with many issues such as domestic labour, patriarchal notions and the family system. The film also highlights how women's sexual desires are suppressed by men and the misconception of 'impurity' associated with menstruating women.


With no background music at all and sparse dialogues, the majority of sounds and visuals in The Great Indian Kitchen are from the daily activities that permeate every household in the country. Cutting, chopping, frying, kneading, washing, sautéing, sweeping, mopping, and all done by the women of the household. Relentlessly, day in and day out, with no respite, honed with precision by years of practice and a silence pregnant with the unspoken exhaustion of these essential but monotonous tasks.

Throughout the film we see the wife and the servant cleaning, sweeping, wiping, polishing and scrubbing, and disposing of dirt and waste. Even though these women clean the house endlessly, they are embodiments of impurity: when they menstruate they are treated as untouchables. On the other hand, the men at home—ever pure—eat, browse, sleep, exercise and copulate, according to their sweet will, bodily needs and spiritual routines. Any hint of discontent or instance of sloppiness at work by women is punished through gentle but brutal rebukes or silent but unrelenting commands. It is this genteel and whispered mode of intimate violence within the family and between the couple that produces the film's chilling effect.





Details of the Programme


Film 'Macbeth' was screened on 10-08-2022 as part of student's curriculum by Film Club. Macbeth (or The Tragedy of Macbeth) is a 1971 historical drama film directed by Roman Polanski and co-written by Polanski and Kenneth Tynan. A film adaptation of William Shakespeare's tragedy of the same name, it tells the story of the Highland lord who becomes King of Scotland through treachery and murder. The film stars Jon Finch as the title character and Francesca Annis as Lady Macbeth, noted for their relative youth as actors. Themes of historic recurrence, greater pessimism and internal ugliness in physically beautiful characters are added to Shakespeare's story of moral decline, which is presented in a more realistic style.

Polanski opted to create an adaptation of Macbeth as a means of coping with the highly publicized Manson Family murder of his wife, Sharon Tate. Finding difficulty obtaining sponsorship from major studios, the production was funded by Playboy Enterprises. Filming was troubled by poor weather around the British Isles. Macbeth was screened out of competition at the 1972 Cannes Film Festival, and was a commercial failure in the United States. The film was controversial for its depictions of graphic violence and nudity, but has received generally positive reviews since its release, and was named Best Film by the National Board of Review. The students watched the movie so enthusiastically till the end.

Details of the Programme

The Film Club of MTM College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Veliyancode, in association with Vimukthi Cell, NSS Unit and IQAC, ran a grassroots engagement initiative through cinema screening, as part of a massive anti-drug movement called 'No to Drugs' by Kerala State Government, at College Open Auditorium on 28 October 2022, Friday to spread the message on the importance of seeking help against drug abuse and lifetime benefits that rehabilitation provides. A Jayasurya-starrer malayalam movie Vellam, written and directed by Prajesh Sen, which dives into the depths of alcoholism and wades into inspirational stuff, was screened to the students to raise awareness about the major challenge that illicit drugs represent to society as a whole, and especially to the young.

Vellam is a 2021 Indian Malayalam-language biographical drama film written and directed by Prajesh Sen. It features Jayasurya and Samyuktha Menon in lead roles with Siddique, Sreelakshmi, Santhosh Keezhattoor, Johny Antony in other supporting roles. The film is based on the life of a Kerala-born businessman Murali Kunnumpurath who turned his life from a full time alcoholic to a successful businessman. The film was released on 22 January 2021. The music was composed by Bijibal.

Prajesh Sen, the writer-director has weaved a deeply moving social drama. Vellam not only discusses the life of an alcoholic but also the stigma that is associated with alcohol abuse. The writer-director has opted to throw light on his society and the individuals who are the victims of alcohol abuse, without going overboard or being preachy. The neatly developed characters, detailed yet highly realistic representation of an alcoholic, highly relatable premise, makes Vellam a deeply moving watch.

However, there are a few scenes that do make the audience uncomfortable (like the scene in which Jayasurya licks spirit from the floor). But such scenes definitely add impact to the overall effect the film creates. The slow pace of the movie might not go well with certain viewers, but such minor flaws did not prevent Vellam from being a highly impactful and relevant film. Vellam is a realistic take on the life of an alcoholic, and what it takes to overcome alcohol



abuse. Jayasurya's powerful performance is unarguably the soul of this deeply moving survival drama.

The film show began at 2.00 pm. The whole students gathered in the open auditorium to watch the movie, a classic redemption tale, based on a particularly dark phase in the life of a real-life person. The movie is not just for the Alcoholic Anonymous but for the people with any type of harmful addiction. This movie made think a lot about how people actually dont seem to realize or think about the mistake that they are committing or the invisible damage that a harmful addiction can do to a person and also to their loved ones. They just dont care about the future. The goal of the programme was to mobilize support and inspire people to act against drug use. The students watched the movie so enthusiastically till the end. The movie was a best example to motivate the students to stay away form addiction to the drugs.






