As part of the Environmental Week celebration, the Film Club and NSS of MTM College jointly organized a documentary film screening on 08/06/2023 Thursday at N1 Hall. The documentary film screened was 'The Elephant Whisperers' by Kartiki Gonsalves, which won the Academy Award for Best Documentary Short Film at the 95th Academy Awards, making it the first Indian film to win an Academy Award in that category at the Oscars. The documentary film focuses on the lives of a couple who takes care of a lost elephant named Raghu from infancy to adulthood. The documentary shows the real-life situations of man and animal co-existing in nature. The Film Club coordinator Mr Hrithuraj CB welcomed the screening session by giving a short introduction to what is meant by the purpose of coexistence in nature. NSS Programme Coordinator Mr Ashik N.P delivered the presidential address providing a viewpoint about the documentary film. College Librarian Mr Faizal Bava gave a short discussion about the theme of



'Value of Human Nature Relationships' after the documentary film screening. The session was concluded by a vote of thanks delivered by the Film club coordinator Mr Hrithuraj CB. The event was targeted to raise awareness about co-existence in nature, with the students seeing and experiencing real life. Through this film screening, students were encouraged to develop a deeper appreciation for nature and understand the importance of human-animal coexistence in nature.

The Film Club's event for the Environmental Week celebration proved to be a resounding success, bringing together individuals from diverse backgrounds to spread awareness on protecting and co-existing with the environment. 
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

Objectives

- To introduce students into the world of professional photography.
- To teach the basic functioning of a professional camera.
- To provide an open platform for students to operate a mirrorless professional camera under manual guidance.
- To inspire students who are interested in professional photography.

Details of the Programme

Introduction:

The Film Club of MTM College Veliyancode, in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), organized a highly informative and engaging one-day workshop on "Introduction to DSLR and Mirrorless Cameras." The workshop aimed to provide students with essential knowledge and practical skills related to these advanced camera technologies, fostering their understanding of photography and videography.



Event Overview:

The workshop took place in the N1 hall at 31-07-2023. It attracted a diverse audience, including students from various disciplines, photography enthusiasts, and individuals interested in improving their camera skills. The event was well-organized and effectively managed, ensuring a smooth flow of activities throughout the day. The workshop was structured with a comprehensive agenda that covered both theoretical and hands-on sessions.

Mr Hrithuraj CB (Assistant Professor, Dept of English) delivered a detailed presentation on the fundamental concepts of DSLR and mirrorless cameras. The discussion covered topics such as camera components, settings, lenses, sensors, and their implications on image quality. Participants were introduced to various camera modes, including manual, aperture priority, and shutter priority modes. The instructor explained the significance of each mode and guided participants on how to choose the appropriate mode for different scenarios. The participants were divided into smaller groups and given access to DSLR and mirrorless cameras for hands-on practice. They were guided through the process of handling the cameras, adjusting settings, and capturing images under the supervision of experienced mentors. An essential aspect of photography, composition techniques, were discussed in this session. The participants learned about the rule of thirds, framing, leading lines, and other techniques that enhance the visual appeal of photographs. The participants were taken outdoors for practical shooting exercises. They applied the knowledge gained from the previous sessions to capture a variety of subjects and scenes. The mentors provided individual guidance to ensure a better understanding of real-time scenarios. The captured images were reviewed collectively, and constructive feedback was provided by both mentors and peers. This session encouraged participants to share their experiences, challenges, and insights. An introduction to post-processing techniques using image editing software was provided. The participants learned about basic adjustments to enhance the quality of their photographs.






