
# MTM ENGLISH LANGUAGE CLUB ANNUAL REPORT: 2021-2022

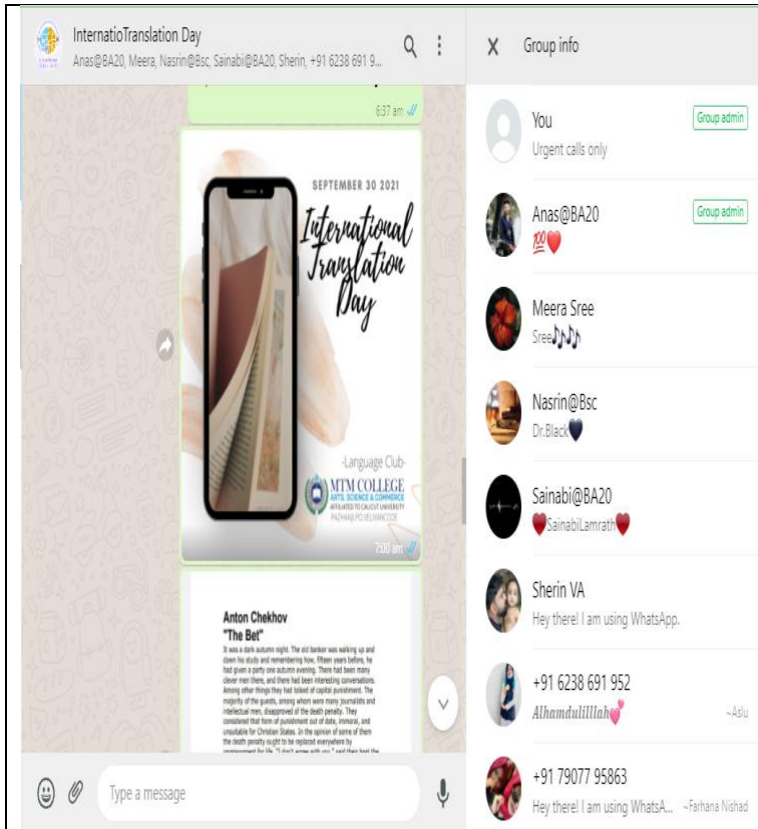
