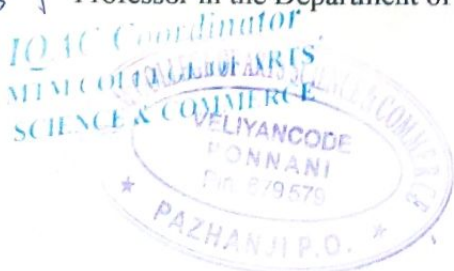
Initiatives and Achievements:
